Store Manager Andrew Mallet has worked at Coles for 25 years and said the team is excited to open the new store and enhance customers' shopping experience.

"It's great to offer our customers the latest store features at a bigger and better supermarket. I think customers will especially love the new in-store bakery," he said.

"The team is really passionate about the community. We have been involved with 'Bears for Hope' for a while, which provides support packages for families experiencing pregnancy and infant loss.
