Mentor Walks operates monthly or bi-monthly in Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Canberra, Perth, Hobart, Wollongong and Armidale (NSW), as well as virtually to provide women from across the country with an opportunity to connect with female leaders regardless of location.
