## GOLDEN STARS RETURN TO GRASSROOTS TO INSPIRE NEXT GEN

Australia's track and field stars will make a return to grassroots Little Athletics centres over the next two weeks to inspire the next generation of Aussie athletes.

Australian hurdles legend **Sally Pearson**, dual World Champion **Jaryd Clifford**, 2018 Commonwealth Games high jump champion **Brandon Starc** and 2022 Commonwealth Games<sup>1</sup> gold medallists, **Kelsey-Lee Barber**, **Matthew Denny** and **Nina Kennedy**, along with Little Athletics ambassadors will visit 45 regional and metro Little Athletics centres across Australia to share their training tips with aspiring athletes.

The appearances are part of Little Athletics Australia's Coles Community Round where kids and families participate in Coles-inspired activities such as banana relays, shopping basket races and Little Athletics' version of 'fashions on the field.'

Coles Ambassador and triple Tokyo Paralympics<sup>2</sup> medallist Jaryd Clifford said he was looking forward to visiting local Little Athletics centres for Coles Community Round.
