Coles pledges up to \$1 million for NSW and QLD flood-affected communities

Fundraising appeal kicks off at Coles supermarkets, Coles Express and Coles Liquor stores

Coles has pledged up to \$1 million to a fundraising appeal for flood-affected communities in NSW and Queensland to enable not-for-profit organisation, GIVIT, to provide emergency and household items to local residents.
